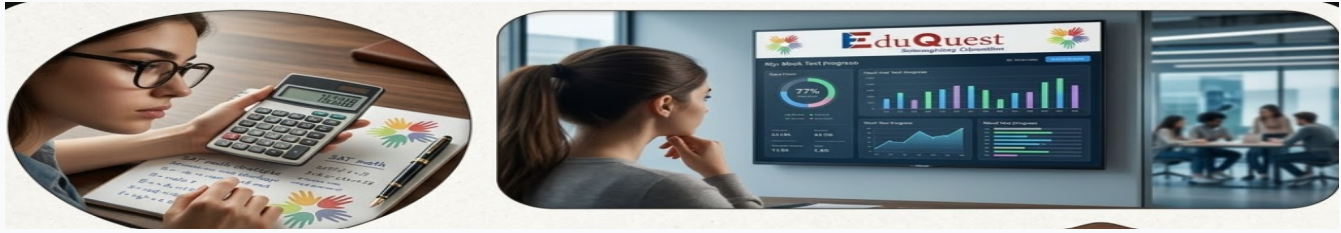

■ 2025–2026 Testing Mandates

Module 2: SAT Exam Multistage Adaptive Testing (MST) Mechanics

1. How the Multistage Adaptive Algorithm Works

Unlike static paper exams or question-by-question computer tests, the SAT Exam adapts at the module level. Both the Reading & Writing and Math sections follow a strict 2-stage routing architecture:

- Module 1 (Routing Baseline): Contains a calibrated balance of easy, medium, and difficult questions. Your raw score on Module 1 acts as a routing trigger.
- Module 2 (Harder / Upper Route): Achieving high accuracy on Module 1 routes you to the Upper Module 2, unlocking maximum score potential (up to 800 per section).
- Module 2 (Easier / Lower Route): Falling below the accuracy threshold routes you to the Lower Module 2, capping your maximum possible section score around 570–600.

You cannot score 1400+ without qualifying for the harder Module 2. Maintaining extreme accuracy in Module 1 is non-negotiable.

Module 3: SAT Exam Reading & Writing (RW) Section Mastery

1. The 4 Content Domains in Reading & Writing

The 54 questions in the RW section test four precisely defined academic skill domains:

Content Domain	Question Share	Tested Concepts & High-Yield Strategy
Craft and Structure	approx. 28% (13–15 Qs)	Words in Context, Text Structure & Purpose, Cross-Text Connections. Focus on tone & context clues.
Information and Ideas	approx. 26% (12–14 Qs)	Central Idea, Command of Textual Evidence, Quantitative Evidence (charts/tables), Inferences.
Standard English Conventions	approx. 26% (11–15 Qs)	Boundaries (semicolons, colons, dashes), Subject-Verb agreement, Verb tense, Modifier placement.
Expression of Ideas	approx. 20% (8–12 Qs)	Rhetorical Synthesis (bullet-point integration) and Logical Transitions (contrast, cause, addition).

2. High-Yield Grammar & Punctuation Rules

Standard English Conventions are 100% rule-based. Memorize these foundational rules:

- **Independent Clauses:** Two complete sentences must be separated by (1) Period, (2) Semicolon, or (3) Comma + FANBOYS (for, and, nor, but, or, yet, so). Never use a comma alone (comma splice).
- **Colons & Dashes:** A colon or single dash must ALWAYS be preceded by a complete independent clause. The text following provides an explanation, list, or dramatic point.
- **Rhetorical Synthesis Shortcut:** Read ONLY the final sentence prompt (the question). Skip reading the bullet points and choose the option that directly fulfills the prompt goal.

Module 4: SAT Exam Mathematics Section Mastery (400–800 Scale)

1. The 4 SAT Exam Math Content Domains

The 44 math questions evaluate algebraic precision, advanced functions, and real-world data reasoning:

Math Domain	Exam Share	Key Topics & Problem Formats
Algebra	approx. 35% (13–15 Qs)	Linear equations in 1 & 2 variables, Linear functions, Systems of linear equations, Inequalities.

2. Student-Produced Responses (Grid-Ins) Protocol

Approximately 25% of math questions are student-produced responses (no multiple-choice options):

- Acceptable Formats: Enter numbers as positive/negative integers, decimals (e.g. 3.75), or improper fractions (e.g. 15/4).
- Never Enter Mixed Numbers: Enter 3 1/2 as 7/2 or 3.5. Entering 3 1/2 will be scored as 31/2 (incorrect).
- No Penalty for Guessing: Always provide an answer for every grid-in question.

Module 5: Top 10 Desmos Graphing Calculator Ninja Hacks for SAT Exam

1. High-Yield Desmos Speed Shortcuts

Every math question allows the built-in Desmos tool. Use these keystrokes to solve complex problems in seconds:

Problem Category	Desmos Keystroke Command	Time Saved & Advantage
System of Equations	Type Equation 1 on line 1, Equation 2 on line 2; tap intersection point	Finds (x, y) solution in 4 seconds with zero algebraic calculation slip.
Quadratic Vertex & Roots	Type $y = ax^2 + bx + c$; click x-intercepts for roots and apex for vertex	Reveals maximum/minimum and axis of symmetry instantly.
Regression & Line of Best Fit	Add table with data points; on line 2 type $y1 \sim mx1 + b$	Computes exact slope m and y-intercept b in under 10 seconds.
Equivalent Expressions	Type original expression as $f(x)$; type choices as $y = g(x)$	The graph that overlays $f(x)$ perfectly is the guaranteed correct answer.
Unknown Constants (k, c, a)	Type equation with constant and add slider; slide to match problem conditions	Solves tangent line and zero/infinite solution questions visually.
Summary Statistics	Type $\text{mean}([values])$ or $\text{median}([values])$ or $\text{stats}([values])$	Computes statistical summaries without manual calculation.

Mastering Desmos eliminates over 80% of algebraic errors and saves 8–10 minutes in the Math section.
