1. High School Non-Profit & Social Venture Blueprint

Founding a high-impact social initiative or student-led non-profit demonstrates leadership, empathy, and organizational vision. Admissions officers look for sustainable impact that moves beyond performative volunteering.

- The Flaw of "One-Off" Volunteering: Collecting 50 hours of generic community service has minimal admissions impact.
- The Founder Paradigm: Identifying an underserved community challenge, engineering a scalable solution, and establishing quantifiable metrics.

■ Social Impact Metric

Focus on deep, quantifiable community outcomes rather than shallow volunteer hour counts.

Module 2: Aligning Social Impact with UN Sustainable Development Goals

1. UN SDG Alignment Framework

UN SDG Goal	Focus Area	High School Non-Profit Project Example
SDG 3: Good Health	Public Health & Medicine	Mobile vision screening initiative for rural school children.
SDG 4: Quality Education	Educational Equity	Peer-to-peer STEM and coding mentoring for underserved schools.
SDG 7: Clean Energy	Renewable Energy & Climate	Solar lamp distribution and energy efficiency workshops.
SDG 8: Economic Growth	Financial Literacy	Financial literacy bootcamps for local micro-entrepreneurs.
SDG 10: Reduced Inequality	Digital Inclusion	Refurbishing donated laptops for underprivileged students.

Module 3: Legal Structuring, Governance & Registration

1. Organizational Structure Options

- Section 8 Company / Trust (India) or 501(c)(3) (USA): Official non-profit registration allowing tax-exempt donations.
- Fiscal Sponsorship: Partnering with an established non-profit (e.g. Hack Club Bank) to receive donations without registering a new entity.
- Executive Board Governance: Establish roles for Director, Outreach Lead, Finance Manager, and Curriculum Lead.

Module 4: Fundraising & Corporate Sponsorships (CSR)

1. Securing Grants & Capital

- Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR): Pitching local corporations with structured grant proposals.
- Crowdfunding Campaigns: Using platforms like GoFundMe or Ketto with compelling video storytelling.
- Ticketed Charity Events: Organizing regional hackathons, art auctions, or sports tournaments to raise capital.

Module 5: Scaling Impact: Chapters & Volunteer Management

1. Expanding Beyond Your School

- The Chapter Model: Create a standardized toolkit that allows students in other cities to launch branches of your initiative.
- Volunteer Training: Design standardized onboarding guides and automated volunteer hour tracking systems.

Module 6: External Validation: Media & Government Partnerships

1. Gaining Institutional Recognition

- Government Partnerships: Secure memorandums of understanding (MOUs) with local school districts or municipal offices.
- Media Coverage: Pitch your milestone achievements (e.g., 5,000 students impacted) to local newspapers and national media.

Module 7: Common App Activity Formatting for Non-Profit Founders

1. High-Impact Activity Descriptions

Example: "Founder & Exec Director, Project Vision (501c3): Expanded to 8 chapters across 3 states; mobilized \$22k funding; screened 4,500 children; partnered with State Health Dept."

1. Impact Readiness Checklist

- Can you measure your social impact in verified quantitative metrics? (Yes / In Progress)
