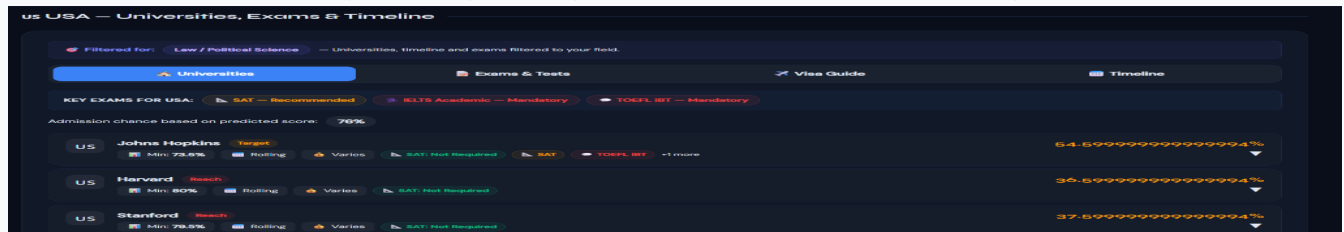
5-Step Research Workflow, Professor Cold-Email Templates, Peer-Reviewed Journal Guide & Avoiding Predatory Scams

1. High School Academic Research Overview

Conducting independent research and publishing a scholarly paper demonstrates intellectual vitality, advanced research methodologies, and academic maturity. It is one of the most effective ways for high school students to build an Ivy League Tier 1 spike.

- The Difference Between a School Essay and a Research Paper: A research paper solves an original, unanswered question or provides novel analysis of primary data.
- The 5 Research Archetypes: Computational / Data Science, Systematic Literature Review, Experimental Lab Science, Mathematical Modeling, Humanities / Archival.

■ Research Distinction

Original peer-reviewed publication provides verifiable evidence of college-level scholarly inquiry.

Module 2: The 5-Step High School Research Workflow

1. Step-by-Step Research Methodology

Phase	Actionable Steps	Key Output Deliverable
1. Literature Review	Read 20+ peer-reviewed papers on PubMed/arXiv; identify gaps.	Annotated bibliography + research question.
2. Methodology Design	Choose analytical framework, dataset, or computational model.	Formal methodology outline.
3. Data Collection & Analysis	Gather data, write Python scripts, run statistical tests.	Clean datasets, graphs, and statistical tables.
4. Manuscript Drafting	Write IMRAD format: Intro, Methods, Results, Discussion.	Full 3,000–5,000 word academic manuscript.
5. Peer Review & Submission	Submit to vetted youth or academic journals.	Official publication / conference acceptance.

Module 3: Securing University Mentors: Cold-Email Templates

1. High-Converting Professor Outreach Strategy

- Read Their Recent Papers: Reference a specific finding or methodology from their last 12 months of publications.
- Offer a Specific Task: Propose assisting with data cleaning, literature synthesis, or a defined computational model.
- Keep it Under 150 Words: Busy professors read emails on mobile devices. Be concise and attach your CV.

1. Template Structure

1. Legitimate High School & Undergraduate Journals

Journal Name	Publisher / Focus	Peer-Review Standards
Journal of Emerging Investigators (JEI)	Harvard Graduate Students / STEM	Rigorous double-blind peer review by PhD candidates.
Curieux Academic Journal	Youth Non-Profit / Multidisciplinary	Peer-reviewed research across sciences and humanities.
National High School Journal of Science	Peer-Reviewed STEM Journal	Rigorous editorial board review of original student research.
The Concord Review	History / Humanities Monograph	Gold standard for high school historical scholarship.
IEEE / Springer Youth Tracks	Professional Academic Conferences	Original computational and engineering contributions.

Module 6: Avoiding Predatory Journals & Pay-to-Play Scams

1. Red Flags of Predatory Publishing

- Guaranteed Publication within 48 Hours: Legitimate peer review takes 4 to 12 weeks.
- Expensive "Author Processing Charges" (APCs): Never pay \$500–\$2,000 to low-quality predatory publishers.

Module 7: Presenting Research on the Common App & Supplements

1. Highlighting Research Impact

- Common App Additional Information: Include paper title, abstract, journal DOI, and faculty mentor name.
- Submit Research Supplements: Upload the full PDF manuscript via Maker / Research portfolios on Slideroom.

Module 8: Research Readiness & Mentorship Booking

1. Research Verification Checklist

- Do you have an original research question that has not been answered identically? (Yes / In Progress)
- Have you analyzed your data using standard statistical tests (p-values, regression)? (Yes / In Progress)
