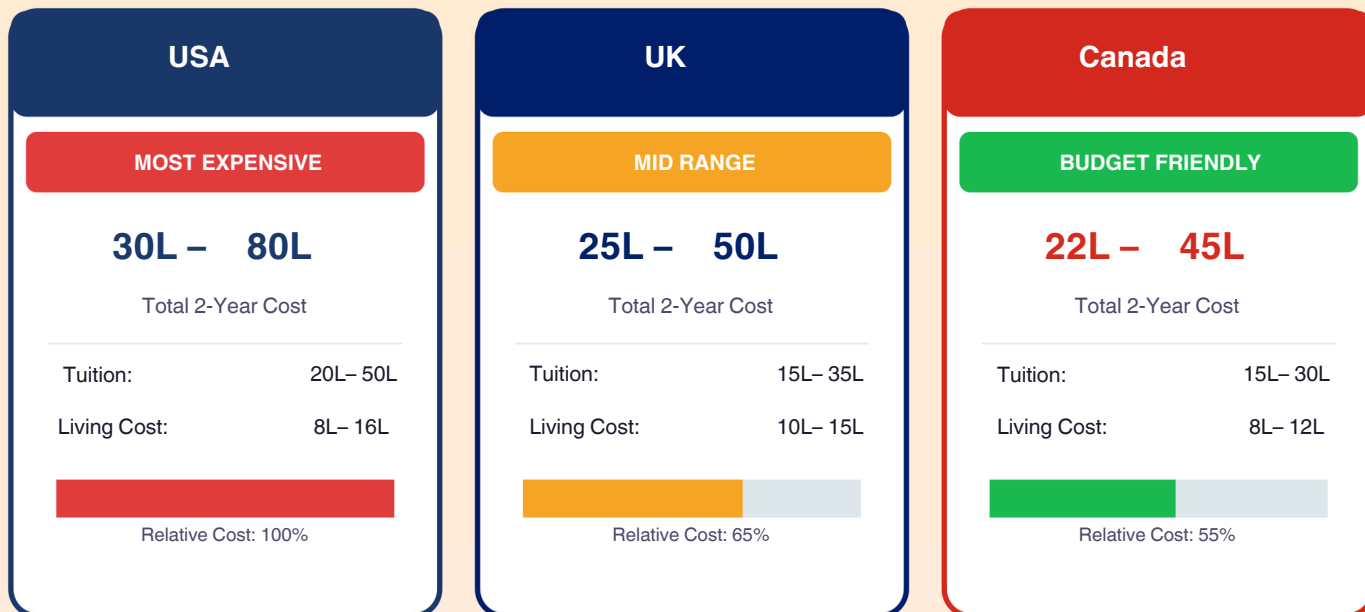

Scholarships can reduce costs by 3L–10L

Choosing affordable cities (not Toronto/London) saves 3L–5L/yr

## Return on Investment (ROI) Analysis

Country	Total Investment	Avg Salary	Payback Period	ROI Rating
USA	30L- 80L	\$70K+	3-5 yrs	Very High
Canada	22L- 45L	\$50K+	2-3 yrs	High
UK	25L- 50L	\$40K+	3-5 yrs	Moderate

USA offers highest ROI but requires higher initial investment

## PR & Immigration Difficulty Comparison

### Canada

#### EASY

- Express Entry system
- Points-based merit system
- PR in 1-2 years possible
- Family can join quickly
- Clear pathway to citizenship

### UK

#### MODERATE

- Skilled Worker Visa route
- Points-based system
- 5 years to PR
- NHS surcharge applies
- Moderate income threshold

### USA

#### VERY HARD

- H-1B lottery system
- Only 85,000 visas/year
- 10-20 year Green Card wait
- Country quota limits Indians
- Highest uncertainty

### Canada

Best for PR & long-term settlement

### UK

Good balance of work+ partial PR

### USA

Best for career, not PR plans

## Jobs & Work Permits After Graduation

### USA

#### OPT: 1–3 Years

- STEM OPT: 3 years work permit
- Highest tech salaries globally
- Silicon Valley, Wall Street access
- H-1B visa required after OPT
- Visa uncertainty is a risk
- Best for: Tech, Finance, Healthcare

### Canada

#### PGWP: Up to 3 Years

- Post-Grad Work Permit: up to 3 yrs
- No lottery system — open work permit
- Job market strong in tech & healthcare
- Work → PR pathway is seamless
- Employer-friendly immigration
- Best for: Tech, Engineering, Nursing

**Job Score: 10/10**

### UK

#### Graduate Route: 2 Years

- 2-year Graduate Route (post-study)
- No job offer needed to get visa
- Strong finance & business sectors
- NHS & academic roles available
- Skilled Worker Visa for longer stay
- Best for: Finance, Medicine, Arts

**Job Score: 7/10**

## 7 Costly Mistakes That Can Waste 10–30 Lakhs

### Choosing Country Based on Hype

Following YouTube influencers or peers instead of data. Every student's profile & goal is different.

✓ **Research your profile: GPA, budget, career goals**

### Ignoring PR & Immigration Options

Students focus on admission but forget that post-study visa & PR are what truly matter long-term.

✓ **Research visa routes BEFORE applying**

### Underestimating Total Costs

Focusing only on tuition fees and forgetting living costs, health insurance, visa fees, flights, setup costs.

✓ **Budget 5-8L extra beyond tuition + living**

### Not Researching Job Market

Choosing a country where your field has poor demand. Leads to unemployment or unrelated jobs.

✓ **Check LinkedIn job market for your field first**

### Applying to Wrong Universities

Choosing university by ranking alone, ignoring ROI, industry connections, or location job market.

✓ **Choose employability over global ranking**

### Missing Scholarship Deadlines

Scholarships can save 5-15L but most students apply too late or don't apply at all.

✓ **Apply 12-18 months before your intake**

### No Backup Plan

Applying to only 1-2 universities or 1 country. Rejection leaves students stranded for a year.

✓ **Apply to 8-10 universities across 2 countries**

## Pro Tips From Study Abroad Consultants

### Apply for Scholarships Early

Most scholarships open 12-18 months before intake. Apply to 5+ scholarships.

- Merit scholarships: 2L–8L savings
- Government scholarships: fully funded
- University grants: automatic on admission

### Choose Affordable Cities

Toronto & London are expensive. Choose smaller cities for 40% lower living costs.

- Canada: Winnipeg, Halifax, Ottawa
- UK: Glasgow, Birmingham, Leeds
- USA: Pittsburgh, Austin, Raleigh

### Work Part-Time While Studying

Part-time work can cover 40-60% of your living expenses. Plan this from day 1.

- Canada: 24hrs/week on-campus allowed
- UK: 20hrs/week during term time
- USA: On-campus jobs available on F-1

### Plan Finances 18 Months Ahead

Forex rates, bank documentation & fund transfers take time. Start early.

- FOREX: Convert when rates are favorable
- GIC/Blocked account: required for Canada
- Loan: Apply 6 months before visa

### Negotiate Tuition & Deadlines

Many universities offer flexibility. Don't accept first offer without negotiating.

- Conditional scholarships can be upgraded
- Deferral possible if visa delayed
- Some universities waive application fees

### Use Technology to Save Money

Apps and tools can save significant money on daily expenses abroad.

- Wise/Revolut for international transfers
- Student discounts on Amazon, Spotify
- Cook at home: save 8,000/month
