## Rankings ARE based on:

- ✓ Research output
- ✓ Faculty citations
- ✓ Global reputation surveys
- ✓ International diversity

## Rankings are NOT based on:

- ✗ Job placement rates
- ✗ Student satisfaction
- ✗ Return on Investment
- ✗ Career outcomes

### Key Insight:

A university ranked #70 can outperform #30 in career outcomes depending on your field, location, and specialisation. Rankings capture academic prestige, not professional success.
